



EDUSS School Server Solution



Server Installation – Setting up the Server

Before Eduss sends you the server, Eduss sends a form requesting certain information about your school's network. One of the things Eduss asks for is an IP Address we can use for the Eduss Server, so we can set the IP Address of the Eduss Server to an address that will be in your school's IP range. Because of this, as soon as you plug in the server and connect it to your network, you should be able to reach it from any workstation on the same network with the same IP range.

1. Plug the server into a wall socket
2. Turn the computer on. You do not need to plug in a monitor, keyboard, mouse or any other device into the server as all the work you need to do is done from a workstation that is connected to the server
3. Insert a network cable
4. Turn on the server
5. Give the computer at least 2 minutes to boot up
6. Go to a workstation
7. Browse to [http://\(Eduss Server IP\)/admin/](http://(Eduss Server IP)/admin/) (For example <http://10.0.0.250/admin/>) in Internet Explorer
8. Login (The default username is 'admin' and the default password is 'admin'. This can be changed through the server's administration control)
9. Click on 'Edit Network Settings'
10. Add any proxy details here if required
11. Choose a drive letter that isn't in use on any of the workstations you wish to run the software on under 'Edit Software Settings'. (The software will automatically map the drive to the drive letter specified the first time you run the software on a workstation)

If your school's IP range changes, follow the instructions below to change the IP address of the server:

1. Go to a workstation that is in the same IP range of the Eduss Server (if you don't have any you will have to temporarily change the IP address of the workstation to be in the same range as the Eduss Server) and browse to [http://\(Eduss Server IP\)/admin/](http://(Eduss Server IP)/admin/) (For example <http://10.0.0.250/admin/>) in Internet Explorer
2. Login as the admin user (by default the username and password is "admin")
3. Click on 'Edit Network Settings'
4. Change the IP Address and any other network information here
5. Click on Submit changes
6. Change the workstation's IP address back to an IP address that is in the same range as the other workstations
7. To test this was successful, browse to [http://\(Eduss Server IP\)/admin/](http://(Eduss Server IP)/admin/) (For example <http://10.0.0.250/admin/>) in Internet Explorer
8. If a login screen appears, then the changes have been made successfully

Workstation Installation – Mathematics

1. Go to a workstation
2. Uninstall any copies of the Mathematics program that may be currently installed. Also ensure that you delete any shortcuts to the Mathematics program that exist
3. Click on the Start button
4. Click on Run
5. Type in \\edusserver\software\ and click on “OK”
6. Open the "Tools" folder.
7. For Windows XP/2000 workstations:
 - Double click on “XP ILS Workstation Setup.exe” and follow the on-screen promptsFor Windows 9x/ME Workstations:
 - ILS Workstation Setup - For 9x/ME Workstations
8. Once the install is complete, click on the Start button
9. Click on Run
10. Type in \\edusserver\software\ and click on “OK”
11. Create a shortcut to Eduss Server.exe on the workstation’s desktop (if there is already a shortcut to Eduss Server.exe on the workstation, you will not need to create another one)
12. Repeat this process on the remaining workstations. (TIP: You can use an application such as Norton Ghost to ghost this first install across to the other workstations)

Workstation Installation – English and Phonics

1. Go to a workstation
2. Uninstall any copies of the English or Phonics program that may be currently installed. Also ensure that you delete any shortcuts to the English or Phonics programs that exist
3. Click on the Start button
4. Click on Run
5. Type in \\edusserver\software and click on “OK”
6. Create a shortcut to Eduss Server.exe on the workstation’s desktop (if there is already a shortcut to Eduss Server.exe on the workstation, you will not need to create another one)
7. Repeat this process on the remaining workstations.

(TIP: You can use an application such as Norton Ghost to ghost this first install across to the other workstations)

Workstation Installation – The Language Market

1. Go to a workstation
2. Uninstall any copies of The Language Market programs that may be currently installed. Also ensure that you delete any shortcuts to The Language Market programs that exist
3. Click on the Start button
4. Click on Run
5. Type in \\edussserver\software and click on “OK”
6. Create a shortcut to Eduss Server.exe on the workstation’s desktop (if there is already a shortcut to Eduss Server.exe on the workstation, you will not need to create another one)
7. Repeat this process on the remaining workstations

(TIP: You can use an application such as Norton Ghost to ghost this first install across to the other workstations)

Running the Eduss Programs

1. Go to a workstation
2. Double click on the Eduss Server.exe shortcut
3. Click on the product you wish to run
